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Notes on the Score

Technical Setup:

- Pickup and pre-amplifier for the violist
- Bass Amplifier for the tape recording
- Guitar Amplifier for the amplified viola's pickup
- Both amplifiers are to be set up in the middle of the stage, near enough to the performer for them to hear the tape part. The amplifiers should be next to each other so as to acoustically blend both parts
- Optional: the viola is run through a hardware compressor post pre-amplifier and pre guitar amplifier. The purpose of the compressor is to assist the viola's sound in having an artificially sounding consistent amplitude. Suggested settings: Attack: 30 ms; Release: 10 ms; Ratio: 8:1; Threshold: set to reduce gain on an average of 6dB.
- Tape playback can be from any device.

Performance Suggestions:

- Considering the number of pages and the absence of rests, an iPad with a foot pedal or similar score reading device is to be used
- Suggested page turning moments are marked with V. S.

Additional Notes:

- SYNTH.wav - this is the tape (accompaniment) track
- VIOLA.wav - this is an assistive track. It lines up exactly with SYNTH.wav. It can be used for practice help or as an 'in-ear' assistive tool for the performance.






